

## Existing Conditions

- The intersection is currently a signalized “T” intersection and serves as the eastern entrance to Lacamas Lake Park. This intersection connects two roads that are critical links between the south shore and north shore areas of Camas. Average daily traffic entering the intersection is well over 15,000.
- The surrounding area includes Lacamas Lake and several smaller lakes, forested and recreational lands owned by the City and Clark County and, to the north along SR 500, the Everett Street Bridge connecting Lacamas Lake and Round Lake.
- The project limits extend from the northern property line of the Camas Produce store to the Everett Street Bridge to the north, and from the end of the sidewalk at Lacamas Lake Lodge to the intersection of the Lake Road and Everett Street intersection.
