From February 22 to March 11, 2019, an online survey captured community members' input on existing conditions and the future intersection design.


1,108 people participated in the survey.

of respondents use the intersection every day


38%

"Reduce traffic congestion, maintain traffic flow during construction, and improve traffic safety."

Were the highest-rated responses when evaluating the criteria used to assess the intersection alternatives, with approximately **half of respondents** rating them each as highest importance.
